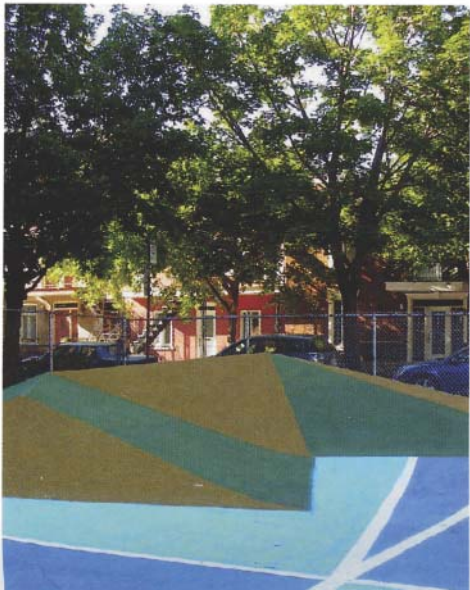
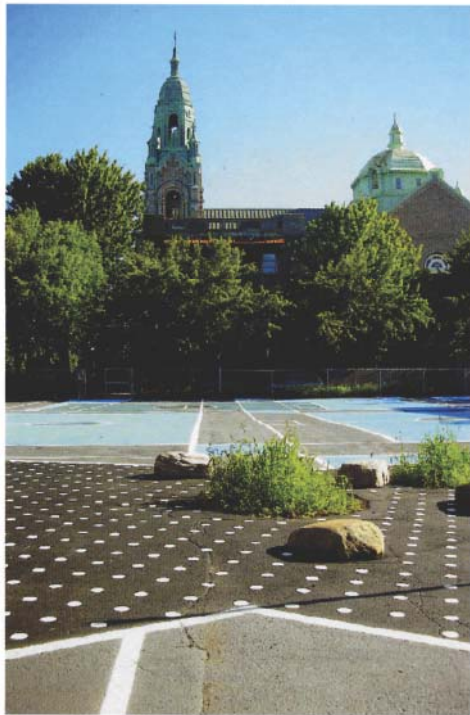

## SCHOOLYARD PAUL BRUCHÉSI

The project organizes the schoolyard through a playful transformation of the horizontal asphalt surface. Using circulation patterns and building volumes, a grid of white lines is established, defining and structuring play and residual spaces. Within the grid, bright blue areas provide various program and play opportunities. Acting as islands, a series of planting beds, a rubber landform, a paved meeting point and a wooden terrace punctuate the yard's otherwise flat surface, allowing a wide range of improvised and unexpected activities.
